HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER AND OBTAIN A TRACTOR KEY

Annual Club Membership and Tractor Key Hire is from September to October.

Go to our website at www.mahiafishingclub.com and complete the online application form. You can pay online. Your tractor key and other information will be sent to your home address.

The application process takes 10 days so to avoid disappointment please do not wait until you arrive in Mahia to arrange your Membership and Tractor Key.

If you are a current member, you will be automatically reinvoiced.

SPECIAL NOTES

Only financial members can obtain and use a Tractor Key.

As a Tractor Key holder, I may be reliable for the cost of recovery and insurance excess if I am responsible for, swamping or damaging a tractor through neglect or misuse.

The Club will provide the venue, promote the Tournament, look after the logistics (Registration, Bar, BBQ, Weigh Master, Radio Operators). You will be required to cover the cost of Prizes and help with running the event.

We are looking for Radio Operators during Tournaments between the hours of 9am-4pm. Full training will be given.
